Non- Standard Lighting Incentives for Business Program

The Non-Standard Lighting Incentives for Business Program from Ohio Edison, The Illuminating Company, and Toledo Edison, FirstEnergy's Ohio utilities (FirstEnergy) offers incentives and information to encourage participants to install high-efficiency lighting equipment. The program is funded by Ohio Edison, The Illuminating Company, and Toledo Edison nonresidential utility customers in Ohio, in accordance with Senate Bill 221.

Effective Dates

To qualify for incentive under this program, equipment must have been purchased on or after April 11, 2011 and the application must be received by October 11, 2011.

Eligible Participants

The Non-Standard Lighting Incentives for Business Programs is available to commercial and industrial retail service customers of FirstEnergy in Ohio. In addition to retrofits, new construction projects and the portion of building addition projects that increase a facility's footprint are eligible for Non-Standard Lighting incentives.

Pre-Approval Requirements

Non-Standard lighting projects will require pre-approval before the purchase and installation of equipment if the total incentive requested is greater than \$3,000.

Limitations

All incentives available from FirstEnergy's commercial and industrial program are limited to the total project cost.
