How does LED save money?

- LED lamps use up to 90% less electricity to operate which will lower electric bills.
- Most LED lamps have a life span of 50,000 hours, 10 times that of a CFL and 20 times that of an average incandescent means less purchase of replacement bulbs.
- LED lamps emit less heat. This means you don't need to increase the cooling in the facility to compensate for heat produced by the lamps. Less air conditioning means less electricity used and equals lower electric bills. Less heat also means no damage to display and merchandise from heat, causing you to replace the items.
- LED lamps are eligible for tax credits and utility company rebates and discounts. Ask your CPA and your local electric utility provider for details.
